

LANDSCAPE WINTER SEASON UPDATE

Residents of Bermuda Greens,

As our beautiful winter season nears a close, we are providing you with a brief update on year-to-date landscape activity and additional work to be completed in the next few months.

While our streets repair project resulted in damage to our lawn edges, grass at the project staging area, and irrigation connections, the amount of repair work did not exceed project expectations. A special thanks to our wonderful partners at Juarez Lawn Care who quickly and expertly restored everything to pre-construction standards.

Work has been completed on the eroded area behind the Hamilton Harbour Circle between the circle's edge and the lake shoreline. The newly installed drain field and the road edge have been resodded and should provide much needed soil support to the area. Also, as part of the community's long-term planning process, our lake management company has completed a shoreline assessment that will assist us in addressing our priority erosion areas.

You may have noticed that, through the years, the plantings at the circle itself have steadily deteriorated to the point that a replanting of the entire area was sorely needed, and the previously budgeted rebuild is underway! Juarez Lawn Care has provided the design that includes a center Palm, Panama Rose trees, Begonias, Croton Mammy's, Schefflera Arboricola Dazzle, Sanchezia speciosa, and Agave americana. Hopefully, the circle will prove to be as beautiful as its Castle Harbour counterpart across the lake!

Upcoming work includes island maintenance in June, as well as the trimming of our hardwoods, Coconut palms, and Fiscus. Our Foxtail, Queen, and Christmas palms will be trimmed later in the summer.
