



Trash Disposal and Use of Dumpster

Residents are reminded of Trash Disposal Rules, Rule #4 (a) (b) & (c), on Pages 1 & 2, .
It's simple really, if we all take care of our own waste.

TRASH Curbside Pickup Thursday & Thursday RECYCLE Curbside Friday's Only

1. Trash cans WITH lids are required when placing trash at the curb.
2. NO plastic bags at the curb, black or otherwise, unless placed in a can with a lid at curbside. This becomes a safety and health issue when trash is picked by the birds, leaving a mess on our streets.
3. If it's in a loose bag, it belongs in the dumpster. Not curbside.
4. Recycle curbside on Fridays in Collier County Approved receptacle. No Plastic Bags.

Dumpster Care

1. Large boxes disposed of in the dumpster must be knocked down. When whole boxes are thrown in the dumpster, they take up a lot of room, creating overflow, requiring Pat to fish them out, break them down and clean up the mess to make room in the dumpster. So please, take care of breaking down your boxes before throwing them in the dumpster.
2. Consider placing knocked down boxes curbside with your recycling or dropping them at the recycling center on Goodlette Frank Rd.
3. PLEASE, Do not leave items, large or small, outside of the dumpster. This increases disposal expenses impacting Bermuda Greens budget, and can subject us to a fine.
4. Large items such as a mattress, chair, lamps, table, old bicycles etc can be placed curbside for Friday pick up. You do not need to call ahead for these household items and there is no charge.
5. Call (239) 252-2380, 48 hours in advance for refrigerators, ovens, TVs, computers, printers etc to schedule a pick up.
