- 1. Meeting was called to order by Lorrie Beaumont
- 2. Claire Marie stated that Proof of Notice was established
- 3. A quorum of board members was established at 5.
- 4. Lorrie made some President comments.
 - a. As previously stated at the October meeting the GIB has installed speed bumps at both the entrance and exit side of the road at the gatehouse. A Collier Co. inspector has visited the site and determined that the speed bumps are not approved and are to be removed.
