



## A Message from Bermuda Greens President, Guy Miata

Good afternoon,

I hope this finds all of you well and enjoying our little slice of paradise here in Bermuda Greens or wherever your little slice happens to be at this moment. I want to thank you for responding to my pickup truck opinion survey. Based on those responses, no change to our existing rules is planned. I'm certain that will please some of you and displease others, however the responses ranged from "yes, absolutely" to "there will be angry villagers with torches and pitchforks if you try this" and in the middle "meh".

The 55 responses broke down as follows:

YES .... 17

NO .....21

Restrictions ..... 17

The majority of the restrictions were all size related. (no extended beds, crew cabs) with covered beds and non-commercial following.

This community has 230 doors, out of which only 55 (approximately 24%) shared their opinion. **Of that 55**, 21 or 38% said no, 17 or 31% said yes, and the remaining 31% said "sort of". Were this a political race I'd say the "NOs" had a plurality of the votes.
