Residents of Bermuda Greens,

As our beautiful winter season comes to a close, we want to provide you with a brief update on our community's year-to-date landscape activity and additional work scheduled to be completed the balance of the year. While 2023 has proved challenging due to the lingering effects of Hurricane Ian, two significant cold snaps and the recent dry conditions, our community continues to rank as one of the most beautiful in the area!

The Landscape Inquiry system has worked very well with (18) requests submitted year-to-date utilizing the process (in addition to direct requests made to the committee and via our community manager). To date, (30) owners have requested work and with few exceptions, all work has been completed. In addition, (8) owners have been referred to Juarez Lawn Care to have improvements made that are not covered by Bermuda Greens (owner pay).

Our Foxtail and Coconut Palms were trimmed in January and will be done again toward the end of the summer including the removal of all pods and boots. The hardwoods will be pruned in July after their growth spurt and prior to the height of the hurricane season. Hopefully all our magnificent trees will be looking spectacular for the 2024 season! Our island, which was trimmed in February, will again be cut back in June, August, and October.

The weeds around our lakes are cut and treated monthly and although water levels are currently low (normal for this time of year) our lake management company feels that, overall, our lakes are healthy. A long-term plan is currently

being developed to address normal shoreline erosion and ensure that our lakes maintain their beauty for many years to come!
