



## Bermuda Greens updates from BG President, Guy Miata

As we now know, from the previous email blast, the front gate will re-open on Wednesday, May 31.

Considering that so many people have left our community for their annual return to all points of the compass, and there is no New Business at this point, I have decided to not hold a BoD meeting this month. There will, most assuredly be a June meeting.

At that meeting I expect there will be a presentation from Hagen Engineering relative to the roadwork planned for (hopefully) next year and a review of some, or maybe all of our rules and regulations.

A few of them come to mind right now that bear repeating.

1. The ban on attaching things to the exterior of the buildings has not been changed. It is still prohibited. Anyone wishing to display the American Flag, until such time as that rule is amended, display your flag by hanging it from your garage door with clips. (See Rule #12 which states in part "*The exterior stucco surface must never be penetrated using nails, screws, etc. Nothing should be suspended from or attached to the exterior of the buildings. The unit owner/lessee shall be held responsible for any expense for such damage*")
2. The no pickup trucks rule has not been changed and, judging from the responses I received when I last asked the question, isn't apt to be changed any time soon. You can have any vehicle you want as long as it fits in your garage with the door closed.
3. 20 pound propane tanks are not only prohibited in our rules and regs, they are also banned by Collier County fire codes. You cannot store 20 pound propane tanks in your garage or in your unit. The North Collier Fire Department has advised that you may have two (2), 2.7 pound gas canisters either together or separate in your unit. I'm not certain how long they'll last, but that is the limit on tank or canister size. Charcoal grills, as they always have been, are allowed to be used on driveways. In all cases, your grill must be at least 10 feet away from the building.
4. Contractors are not permitted to work in the community before 8AM or after 5PM and never on Sundays. We have had more than a few incidents in the past where contractors are working, on a non-emergency basis, during those exclusion times.
