

Hurricane Milton Preparation Notice for Bermuda Greens

Dear Residents,

As Hurricane Milton approaches, it is crucial for all of us to take the necessary precautions to ensure the safety of our community. Collier County could be impacted by high winds, heavy rainfall, and potential flooding. To help you prepare, I have outlined important steps and guidelines specific to our condo association.

Bermuda Greens is in Evacuation Zone C

Publix will close at 3pm today

1. Stay Informed:

- Monitor Updates: Stay updated through local news, weather alerts, and the National Hurricane Center.
- Association Updates: We will keep residents informed of any property-related issues, such as power outages, damage, or evacuations, via email and the resident portal.

2. Emergency Supply Kit:

Be sure to have a fully stocked emergency kit that can last at least three days, including:

- Water (one gallon per person per day)
- Non-perishable food
- Flashlights and extra batteries
- Prescription medications
- First aid supplies

- Battery-powered radio
- Important documents in waterproof packaging
- Sanitation and hygiene products

3. Prepare Your Condo Unit:

- **Balconies & Patios:** Remove or secure all outdoor furniture, potted plants, and any other items that could become projectiles during high winds.
- **Windows & Doors:** Close and lock all windows and doors. If your unit has storm shutters, please ensure they are properly secured.
- **Valuables:** Move important belongings and documents to higher ground to protect them from possible flooding.

4. Common Areas:

- Pat is securing the property and preparing all common areas for the storm.

5. Evacuation Plan:

- **Know Your Evacuation Zone:** Find out your evacuation zone by visiting colliercountyfl.gov/hurricane and plan your route if an evacuation is ordered, this site also have shelter information
- **Shelters:** Be aware of nearby shelters and make arrangements for any special needs or pets, as not all shelters are pet-friendly by visiting colliercountyfl.gov/hurricane

6. Power & Utilities:

- **Charge Devices:** Fully charge your phones, tablets, and other essential devices, and have battery backups ready.

- Utility Shutoff: In case of emergency, be familiar with how to shut off utilities in your unit.

7. After the Storm:

- Stay Indoors: Do not leave your unit until authorities confirm it is safe. Be mindful of hazards like fallen trees, power lines, and flooding.
- Report Damage: If your unit or common areas have suffered damage, please report it to the property management team immediately, May Management 239-262-1396.
- Avoid Flooded Areas: Stay clear of standing water, as it can be hazardous.
